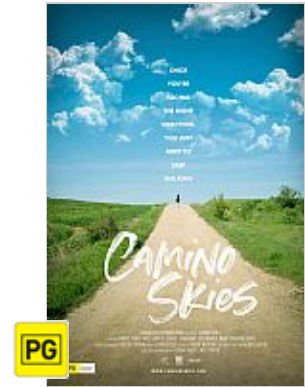

## **Downton Abbey** (PG) *12 Sep - 09 Oct*

The continuing saga of the Crawley family and the servants who work for them in the English countryside in the early 20th century. Mild themes CC/AD 125 minutes

## **Amazing Grace** (G) *19 Sep - 25 Sep*

A documentary presenting Aretha Franklin with choir at the New Bethel Baptist Church in Watts, Los Angeles in January 1972. Dir. Alan Elliott, Sydney Pollack. 92 minutes

## **Palm Beach** (M) *21 Sep - 21 Sep*

A drama/comedy about a group of lifelong friends reuniting to celebrate a special birthday, with Sydney's iconic Palm Beach providing a stunning backdrop for the unfolding drama. The good times roll, with loads of laughter, lavish meals, flowing wine and fantastic music, but slowly tensions mount and deep secrets arise. Coarse language CC/AD 104 minutes

## **Camino Skies** (PG) *22 Sep - 23 Sep*

The inspirational documentary of six strangers from NZ and Australia who embark on the historic 800 km Camino De Santiago walking trek in northern Spain. Mild coarse language 84 minutes

## **Ad Astra** (M) *03 Oct - 16 Oct*

He uncovers secrets which challenge the nature of human existence and our place in the cosmos. Science fiction themes, violence, occasional coarse language CC/AD 130 minutes

Teresa Palmer, Sam Neill. The story of Michelle Payne, the first female jockey to win the Melbourne Cup. Mild themes & coarse language CC/AD 102 minutes

## **The Australian Dream** (MA) *17 Oct - 23 Oct*

The Australian Dream is a documentary that uses the remarkable and inspirational story of Indigenous AFL legend Adam Goodes as the prism through which to tell a deep and powerful story about race, identity and belonging. 115 minutes

A Chinese family discovers their grandmother has only a short while left to live and decide to keep her in the dark, scheduling a wedding to gather before she dies. Starring Awkwafina, Tzi Ma and Diana Lin CC/AD 103 minutes

A boy in New York is taken in by a wealthy Upper East Side family after his mother is killed in a bombing at the Metropolitan Museum of Art. Mature themes, drug use, violence & coarse language CC/AD 155 minutes

Why was Elsa born with magical powers? The answer is calling her and threatening her kingdom. Together with Anna, Kristoff, Olaf and Sven, she'll set out on a dangerous but remarkable journey. 105 minutes
