Farmageddon (G) *9 to 24 Jan*

A Shawn the Sheep movie. When an alien with amazing powers crash-lands near Mossy Bottom Farm, Shaun the Sheep goes on a mission to shepherd the intergalactic visitor home before a sinister organization can capture her. 89 minutes

Ford vs Ferrari (M) *16 to 19 Jan*

American car designers battle corporate interference, the laws of physics and their own personal demons to build a revolutionary race car for Ford and challenge Ferrari at the 24 Hours of Le Mans in 1966. Coarse language CC/AD 158 minutes

Jumanji The Next Level (PG) *16 to 29 Jan*

A team of friends return to Jumanji to rescue one of their own but that nothing is as they expect. The players need to brave parts unknown, from arid deserts to snowy mountains, in order to escape the world's most dangerous game. Mild fantasy violence, coarse language & crude humour CC/AD 125 minutes

Ten fisherman from Cornwall are signed by Universal Records and achieve a top ten hit with their debut album of Sea Shanties. Coarse language 117 minutes

Little Women (G) *23 Jan to 5 Feb*

Four sisters come of age in America in the aftermath of the Civil War. 140 minutes

The Good Liar (MA) *30 Jan to 5 Feb*

Consummate con man Roy Courtney has set his sights on his latest mark: the recently widowed Betty McLeish, worth millions. But this time, what should have been a simple swindle escalates into a cat-and-mouse game with the ultimate stakes. Strong coarse language and violence CC/AD 117 minutes

Spies in Disguise (PG) *31 Jan to 2 Feb*

When the world's best spy is turned into a pigeon, he must rely on his nerdy tech officer to save the world. Mild themes & animated violence 105 minutes

Official Secrets (MA) *2 to 3 Feb*

The true story of a British whistleblower who leaked information to the press about an illegal NSA spy operation designed to push the UN Security Council into sanctioning the 2003 invasion of Iraq. strong coarse language 118 minutes

Judy & Punch (MA) *6 to 10 Feb*

Mia Wasikowska, Damon Herriman, Benedict Hardie. Seaside (nowhere near the sea), puppeteers Judy and Punch are trying to resurrect their marionette show in an an anarchic town on the brink of mob rule. Strong violence 111 minutes

Cats (G) *6 to 12 Feb*

A tribe of cats called the Jellicles must decide yearly which one will ascend to the Heaviside Layer and come back to a new Jellicle life. Very mild themes 114 minutes

The Gentlemen (MA) *6 to 12 Feb*

A British drug lord tries to sell off his highly profitable empire to a dynasty of Oklahoma billionaires. Strong coarse language and violence 119 minutes

Portrait of a Lady on Fire (M) *8 to 12 Feb*

On an isolated island in Brittany at the end of the eighteenth century, a female painter is obliged to paint a wedding portrait of a young woman. Mature themes & nudity 127 minutes

JoJo Rabbit (M) *13 to 19 Feb*

A World War II satire that follows a lonely German boy named Jojo (Roman Griffin Davis) whose world view is turned upside down when he discovers his single mother (Scarlett Johansson) is hiding a young Jewish girl (Thomasin McKenzie) in their attic. Aided only by his idiotic imaginary friend, Adolf Hitler (Taika Waititi), Jojo must confront his blind nationalism. Mature themes, violence and coarse language 114 minutes
